INVITATION FOR INTERNATIONAL ELECTION OBSERVERS TO OBSERVE

THE 2025 GENERAL ELECTIONS IN THE UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA

Pursuant to section 85(4) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Councillors Elections Act No. 1 of 2024 read together with regulation 13(1) and (2) of the Presidential, Parliamentary and Councillors Elections Regulations, 2025, the Commission has mandate to invite organisations and institutions that intend to observe the Presidential, Parliamentary and Councillors Elections.

Through this invitation, the Commission would like to extend invitation for applications from international institutions or organisations that intend to observe general elections in 2025.

The applications should be submitted through the Accreditation Management System (AMS) available through https://ams.inec.go.tz.

An application should include the following: -

- (i) address of the institution or organisation;
- (ii) physical address of the institution or organisation;
- (iii) activities performed by the institution or organisation as specified in their registration documents;
- (iv) areas in which the institution or organisation plans to conduct observation;
- (v) number of individuals from an institution or organisation who will participate in the observation of the election process including their particulars;
- (vi) names and telephone numbers of the office bearers of institutions or organisations;
- (vii) a copy of the institution or organisation's registration certificate; and

(viii) a copy of the institution or organisation's constitution.

The Commission will only consider applications lodged through the aforementioned link that is https://ams.inec.go.tz.

The deadline for receiving applications shall be 20th May 2025.

The commission shall not be responsible for funding any institution or organisation accredited to observe the general elections.
